

# **Privacy Statement**

With this privacy statement we, Ex Libris, would like to inform you about our collection, handling and storage of personal data and our purposes in doing so. This statement applies to all of our activities on all online platforms and to our merchandising activities during gigs or other appearances.

#### Why do we collect your personal data?

The purposes in collecting and processing your personal data are as follows:

- Out of necessity for recent and future agreements
- For an overview of our business administration.

## What personal data do we collect?

We collect the following information:

- First and last name
- Address details (including country / country code / continent)
- E-mail address
- Expenditure per order
- And other information asked during the web shop's checkout

We do not collect sensitive personal information. Examples of sensitive personal information include gender, race and sexual orientation.

#### How do we collect your personal data?

We collect your personal data through our e-mailaddresses info@exlibrismusic.com, finance@exlibrismusic.com, bookings@exlibrismusic.com, webshop@exlibrismusic.com or through the platforms we use for our online activities, such as Facebook, Instagram or PayPal. Please note that the these parties also collect data. We advise you to read the privacy statements of these parties so that you are aware of how your data is handled.
